GIN

Juniper

Clean, crisp and bold with juniper dominating, balanced by citrus and herbaceous notes. This is the traditional gin style perfect for gin and tonic whilst also being extremely versatile.

London Dry

Despite the name, London Dry Gin can be produced anywhere in the world. It is very dry, light-bodied and pungent and represents what most people think of when they think about gin.

Navy Strength

"Navy strength" is a relatively new term. It was coined by the branding consultant John Murphy on behalf of Plymouth Gin in 1993 for something very old — what used to be called 100° UK proof spirit. It refers to a spirit that is bottled at exactly 57% alcohol by volume

Plymonth

Slightly less dry than a London Dry Gin and more earthy in flavour, Plymouth Gin can only be produced in Plymouth using the water from the springs found in Dartmoor.


Old Tom

A sweet style gin very popular in the 18th and 19th centuries; in flavour profile, it sits between Genever and London Dry. It is seeing a resurgence in popularity due to the accelerating craft cocktail movement.

New Western

An umbrella term for a new wave of gins which is alternatively called New

American or International Style. Commonly, these gins have low levels of juniper and a wider, more unusual range of botanicals; many are made by small distillers who each try to add their own unique stamp to the gin.




A blend of a number of malts and produced at various distilleries.



RUM

Brugal Añejo, West Indies 38% £3.90

The nose is full of caramel and dark brown sugar, buttery toffee and a little spice with pepper and vanilla. The palate is smooth, rich and rather dry with buttery spice notes, dark sugar and a little oak. The finish is of good length with dark sugar.

Diplomatico Reserva Exclusiva West Indies 40%

An exquisite sipping rum that is made almost entirely from sugar cane honey. This fine rum is made with 80% heavy pot still rum and 20% lighter column still rum and aged for up to 12 years. The result is a truly exceptional rum with characteristic soft and fruity flavours to an even higher level of concentation than it's family members.

Ron Jeremy, Caribbean 40%

The rum itself is a 8 year old dark rum from Panama, hand-crafted by Master Distiller Don Pancho Fernandez. We've tried this rum, and have to say that we're really impressed.
